


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Knock-down rate: 87 %

Lanes: 1. HeLa cells transfected with Renilla Luciferase esiRNA (RLUC, Cat.No. EHURLUC) as negative control. 2. HeLa cells transfected with FANCD2 esiRNA (Cat.No. EHU029261).

Quantitative-Immunoblotting: Lysates were separated on SDS-Page and probed with mouse anti-GFP (1:3000) (Roche) and goat anti-GAPDH (1:7000) (Acris) anti-bodies. The signal intensities of indicated bands were quantified using an Odyssey infrared imaging system (Li-COR) and normalized to the GAPDH signal. At 72h post transfection, a 87% GFP-FANCD2 protein reduction was measured between the negative control RLUC and the sample treated with FANCD2 esiRNA.

HeLa cells: FANCD2 was NFLAP tagged (including GFP) on a bacterial artificial chromosome (BAC) and stably integrated into the genome of HeLa cells (MCB: ky_5824). The BAC preserves the genomic context of the gene, thereby ensuring near physiological expression (Poser I. et al Nat Methods. 2008 May;5(5):409-15).
